LOGO DESIGN COMPETITION



As part of our journey as a new Faculty Club, the NUS College Club held a design competition for the club's new logo.

With 4 shortlisted designs, the selected logo was ranked first by 66% of voters and second by 23% of voters. The logo was designed by (then) Year 3 student Ang Jun Yi.

Centrally, the globe is surrounded by the orange question mark, signifying our enduring curiosity to learn from global perspectives and beyond. The globe is further adorned with connected orange dots to represent the making of connections between a global and interdisciplinary student populace. Finally, the arrow's upward orbit around the globe symbolizes our pursuit for greater achievements.

In yet another exhilarating edition of her Zumba sessions, Erika reinvigorated NUS College students once more during NUSC's Wellness Week!



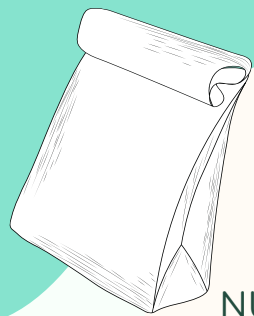
Irrespective of experience, all were welcomed to immerse in an exciting fusion of dance and music to blow off some steam during the busy exam season.
